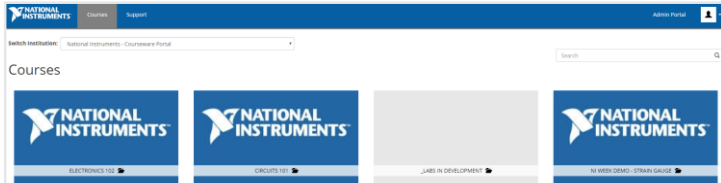


Viewing a Submitted Lab Report
